Virtual Meeting on "Fostering a Culture of Modesty" Organized for Nau Mubai'ats

On 18th May, 2025, the Nau Mubai'at Secretariat of Lajna Ima'illah Ghana organized а virtual meeting for Nau Mubai'ats (New Converts) on the important topic "Fostering a Culture of Modesty." The session was chaired by Madam Rashida Abu, General Secretary Lajna Ima'illah Ghana, and featured key speakers and Q&A session. а

The program commenced with a recitation from the Holy Qur'an. In her

opening remarks, the chairperson explained that modesty is an act of faith and quoted a Hadith: "Every religion has its distinct characteristic, and the distinct characteristic of Islam is modesty."

The main speaker, Madam Rahmat Osei Tutu, focused on three key terms in the theme: fostering, culture, and modesty:

Fostering implies nurturing or encouraging the growth of something over time.

Culture refers to shared values and behaviors passed down within a community.

Modesty, in Islam, means humility and respect in dress, speech, and behavior.

She emphasized that modesty goes beyond clothing—it shapes interaction, attitude, and worship. Quoting a Hadith, she said, "Modesty is all virtue." She urged participants to wear loose clothing, observe purdah, and be mindful in interactions.

The session included a Q&A segment. In her closing remarks, Madam Rashida Abu reiterated the importance of dressing modestly and observing purdah as a reflection of Islamic values.

Members were grouped to deliberate on each topic and presented their findings.

The outcomes of the Shurah will be submitted to Hazrat Khalifatul Masih V (aba) for final approval, In Shaa Allah. The event concluded with the departure of participants on Sunday, 25th May 2025.

Guidelines to Lajna Imaillah," offering motivating guidance from our beloved Khulafa. Awards were presented to outstanding members for their dedication and service.





Caring for Women's Health - Know Your Body, Protect Your Future

Taking care of your health is not selfish. It is part of being a responsible Muslim woman. When you are healthy, you can serve better, pray better, and live better. Islam teaches us balance in all things — including caring for our bodies.

Here are a few key areas every woman should pay attention to:

1. Blood Pressure & Heart Health

High blood pressure is called a "silent killer" because it shows no signs — but it can lead to serious problems like stroke, heart failure, or kidney damage.

Tip: Check your blood pressure at least once every 3 months, especially if you're above 30 or have a family history.

#### 2. Breast Health

Breast cancer is one of the leading causes of death among women — but early detection can save lives.

- Tip: Learn how to do a self-examination monthly. If you feel any unusual lumps or changes, see a doctor early.
- 3. Reproductive Health

Issues like painful periods, irregular bleeding, or infections should never be ignored. Many women suffer in silence.

- Tip: Don't be shy speak to a female doctor or midwife. Early treatment prevents future problems.
- 4. Mental Health Matters Too

Stress, anxiety, and emotional exhaustion are real. As Muslim women, we turn to prayer — but also need to rest, talk, and take breaks.

💡 Tip: Make time for yourself. A walk, a nap, or talking to a friend can refresh your spirit.

#### Final Reminder:

Don't wait until you're sick before you take your health seriously. Prevention is better than cure. Eat balanced meals, drink enough water, sleep well, and seek medical help when needed.
